

# BLACK CABRA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Description:** We strive to achieve a great value, varietally-correct Cabernet Sauvignon with flavors of cassis, berry jam, and a hint of pepper with a long and creamy finish.

**Label Notes:** Our wines, like the Black Cabra (goat), come from the Argentine Andes.

**Malolactic Fermentation:** 100%

**Aging:** 8 months in oak barrels

**Alcohol:** 13.5

**Residual Sugar:** 2.8 g/L

**Acidity:** pH of 3.7; TA of 5.5 g/L
