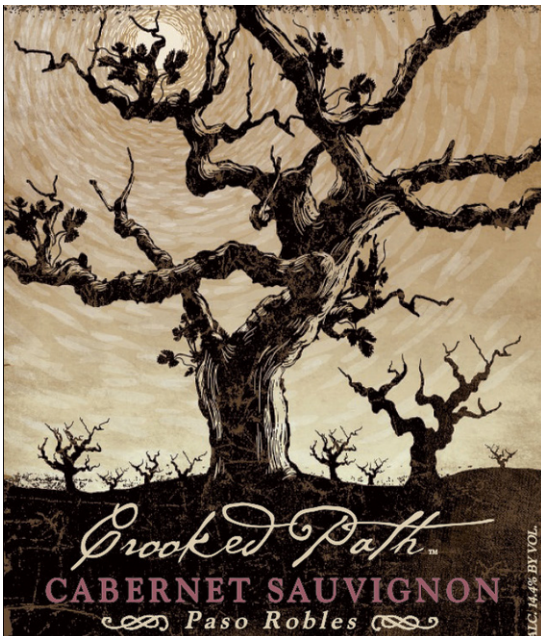


CROOKED PATH

Cabernet Sauvignon

Description: A lively core of vibrant acidity and supple tannins frame undulating contours of plums, figs, raspberries, and cherries. Hints of smoky pepper, dark chocolate, and dusty sage appear on the appealing finish that lingers with freshness and persistence.

Label Notes: When you come across a crooked path you must decide if it is a road worth taking. Our path begins and ends in the historic California wine region of Paso Robles where the warm days and cool evenings are perfectly suited to producing exceptional fruit.
