

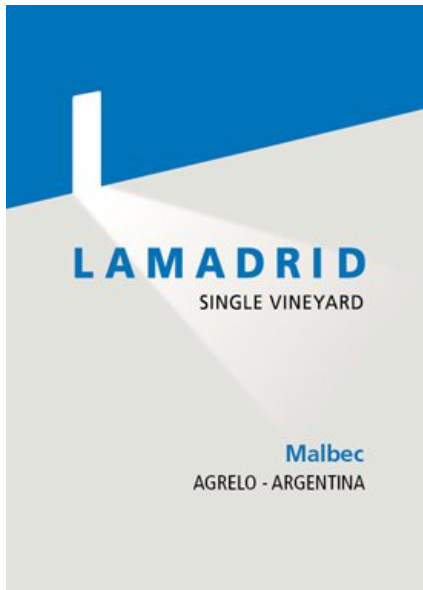
LAMADRID MALBEC

Acidity: pH of 3.50; TA of 5.7 g/L
