

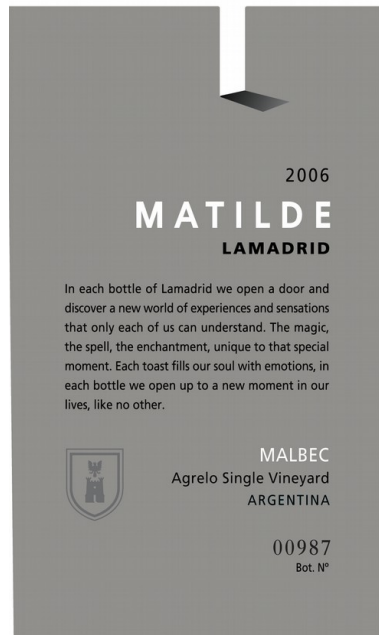
LAMADRID MALBEC MATILDE

for 5 days at 22C

Winemaking: No stabilization, no filtration, no clarification; 20% bleed-off

Aging: 24 months in first-use French oak barrels

Alcohol: 14.5

Residual Sugar: 0.22%

Acidity: pH of 3.77; TA of 5.8 g/L
