

# TAPIZ MALBEC BLACK TEARS

**Description:** We strive for a very concentrated and complex Malbec representing the best of its San Pablo, Valle de Uco *terroir*.

**Label Notes:** Tapiz is Spanish for "tapestry," as in the tapestry between the wine's high-altitude fruit and oak. The wine is called Black Tears because of the amazing color intensity.

**Varietal:** 100% Malbec

**Average Age of Vines:** 14 years

**Harvest Method:** By hand

**Sorting:** Double manual selection

**Fermentation and Maceration:** A cold pre-maceration takes place (8°C) for 5 days to extract color and aromas. Fermented in stainless steel tanks for approximately 15 days at 28°C.

**Malolactic Fermentation:** 100% in oak

**Aging:** 24 months in new French oak barrels.

**Alcohol:** 14.5

**Residual Sugar:** 2.9 g/L

**Acidity:** pH of 3.65; TA of 6.0 g/L
