

ZAHA Cabernet Franc



Place: Toko Vineyard, Paraje Altamira, San Carlos county, Uco Valley

Varietals: 100% Cabernet Franc.

Lot Selection: Cabernet Franc is a varietal which loves limestone soils. In its famous home of St. Emilion, it is planted on the calcareous hilltops and makes up the dominant part of the blend in great harvests.

The soils of Altamira are strewn with limestone soil patches, complete with white surface stones. This is where we have planted our Cabernet Franc.

With different harvest times, each date produces a distinct profile of aromas, flavors and textures to add to the final blend: foral and herbal notes in the early harvest; dark, ripe red fruits and supple textures in the middle dates, and finely grained, well-structured tannins in the later harvests.
