
ZOLO SIGNATURE ROSE

Vineyards: Estate Las Llamas vineyard in Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo where the soil and climate conditions favor the long-cycle varieties such as Cabernet Franc. In the case of Bonarda, wines of very good color and structure are obtained. Estate El Jarillal vineyard in Alto Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo is a very steep area with fresh air at night and very good sunshine. This give grapes a great aromatic intensity and very good health. Syrah does well here.
