Introducing GEN5 Sauvignon Blanc

The Situation:

According to AC Nielsen 26 Weeks April, 2020:

- Wine consumers are looking for quality and value under \$15
- Domestic \$10-\$15 price segment represents largest \$ share generating +10% growth latest 26 weeks
- GEN5 brand fueling +28% \$ sales growth latest 26wks outpacing 3x faster than price segment category
- GEN 5 brand lead by Cabernet (+28%), Chardonnay (+30%) and Zinfandel (+59%)
- Domestic Sauvignon Blanc in \$10-\$15 represent largest \$ share generating (+17%) \$ growth latest 26 wks
- Domestic Sauvignon Blanc is the 2nd largest selling white varietal behind Chardonnay and 5th top selling varietal over-all.

The Idea:

Capitalize on the growing Sauvignon Blanc trends by introducing a Sauvignon Blanc from Gen5. Sauvignon Blanc overall is +9.8% in volume nationally. Consumers are drinking domestic wines 3 to 1 over imports. GEN 5 provides a great opportunity in the domestic category for consumers looking for a crisp, refreshing wine that is an alternative to NZ Sauvignon Blancs.
