When you come across a crooked path you must decide if it is a road worth taking. Our path begins and ends in the historic California wine region of Paso Robles where the warm days and cool evenings are perfectly suited to producing exceptional fruit. We hope you enjoy the journey.

Crooked Path Zinfandel

**89 points, International Wine Review ('17);
89 points, Wine Enthusiast ('16).**

85% Zinfandel, 10% Syrah, 5% Petite Sirah. Hand-picked from our Estate Vineyard in the El Pomar sub AVA of Paso Robles.

Dark in color with an intense nose this Zinfandel is equal parts brooding and approachable. At its core this wine explodes with ripe blackberry and juicy raspberry. Rich on the palate with white pepper spice and dark fruits yet elegant with refined tannins this wine carries to a lingering finish highlighted by the sweet vanilla character of fine oak (2 years in French and American barrels).

Crooked Path Cabernet Sauvignon

90 points, Wine Enthusiast ('18).

A lively core of vibrant acidity and supple tannins frame undulating contours of plums, figs, raspberries, and cherries. Hints of smoky pepper, dark chocolate, and dusty sage appear on the appealing finish that lingers with freshness and persistence. Our Paso Robles appellation continues to produce expressive and balanced Cabernet Sauvignon fruit with signature quality and finesse. 20% aged for 8 months in French oak barrels.

Crooked Path "The Wanderer"

92 points, International Wine Review ('17).

This crooked path finds itself wandering down rows of Grenache, Syrah and Petite Sirah creating a lush and full-bodied red wine with layers of balanced flavors. You'll first notice a deep ruby red color, followed by jammy aromas of cherries and blackberries. Along the way you will discover bold and well-balanced ripe fruit with hits of vanilla ending with a long and smooth finish.



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
