Winemaking: No stabilization, no filtration, no clarification; 20% bleed-off

Aging: 18 months in new and second-use French oak

Alcohol: 14%

Residual Sugar: 1.8 g/L

Acidity: pH of 3.47; TA of 5.4 g/L
