VINTAGE NOTES

WINERY INFORMATION: LangeTwins is a fifth generation Lodi winery with over 5,000 acres of estate fruit. Our vineyards are certified green by Lodi Rules Sustainable Wine-growing.

LABEL NOTES: For five generations the Lange family has lived and worked our land in California, always striving to leave the land in a better state for the next generation.

CLIMATE: Classic Mediterranean. Our vineyards take advantage of the gap between the northern and southern coastal ranges surrounding the San Francisco Bay. As the day's temperature rises, cool breezes drift in from the Delta, keeping the nights cool which is ideal for the development of complexity in finished wines.

WINEMAKING: Consistent vineyard sourcing from Clarksburg, in Sacramento Delta, surrounded by water. Grapes crushed to tank. Cold soaking 2-3 days, then fermented cool with a yeast specially selected for premium Pinot Noir. Pressing at dryness. Aging in tank for development with low level French oak, to enhance the fruit and add mouth-feel to the wine. Blended for complexity.

COLOR: Brilliant light garnet

TASTING NOTES: Aromas of plums, raspberries and black cherries with notes of mocha, cola and vanilla. Medium-bodied, soft tannins, balanced, integrated sweet oak with a lingering red fruit finish.
