VINTAGE NOTES

WINERY INFORMATION: Tara Wines is an exclusive project from Ventisquero Wine Estates. It is an invitation to connect, to celebrate, and to gather with our people. No matter the place, the region, or the country there is still the need to connect with the wine, to talk about them, to laugh, to remember why we are here to enjoy life.

SOIL: Calcareous, with alluvial soils located on the third terrace of the river Huasco in the Nicolasa area. Both the soil profile and the irrigation waters from the River Huasco have a significant level of saline.

FERMENTATION: The pressing was carried out with 30% to 50% of whole bunches depending on the condition of the grapes in each season. No acids, sulphur dioxide, stabilizers or any other product foreign to the grapes were added. Fermentation is carried out with native yeasts and without the addition of foreign products to the wine.

AGING: This wine was aged in solera type, 30% in French barrels and 70% in stainless steel, which means the youngest vintage fills the previous one. At the time of blending, the different vintage years are proportionally mixed. The first vintage was harvested in 2011, so it was aged for seven years at the time of blending. The younger vintage was aged for 10 months. The wine was not clarified or filtered, so all its fine lees can be found in the bottle. This gives it a special and unique character of expression of place.

COLOR: Medium lemon

TASTING NOTES: An aromatically complex wine with different layers, revealing notes of candied orange peel, orange blossom, lime, sponge cake and dried fruit. The palate is broad and well-structured but tense at the same time. It is very fresh, with special persistence and there is a saline note on the finish that is a characteristic of the wines from this area of the Atacama Desert.
