TEHO MEANS "BLOOD OF THE EARTH" IN THE LOCAL HUARPE INDIAN LANGUAGE OF MENDOZA. THIS WINE IS MEANT TO REPRESENT THE ESSENCE OF OLD VINE MALBEC IN THE PRIVILEGED, HIGH ALTITUDE MALBEC TERROIR OF MENDOZA. THE TOMAL VINEYARD, WHICH MEANS "ANCIENT" IN HUARPE, WAS PLANTED IN THE 1950S. WITH DEEP, SPRAWLING ROOTS, THE VINES IN THE TOMAL VINEYARD LITERALLY EXTRACT THE "BLOOD OF THE EARTH" FROM DEEP WITHIN THE ROCKY LIMESTONE SUB SOIL.

OLD VINE MALBEC IS WELL KNOWN FOR ITS MINIMAL YIELDS OF SMALL CLUSTERS AND TINY BERRIES. THE VINE'S NATURAL BALANCE IMPARTS DELICATE, PERFUMED FLORAL AROMATICS; DEEP, DARK FRUIT FLAVORS; AND A RICH YET SUPPLE TEXTURE. THE TOMAL VINEYARD'S LIMESTONE SOIL PROFILE LENDS A MARKED MINERALITY TO THE LENGTHY FINISH.
