“Las Vertientes” refers to the slopes in the Andes that carry the snowmelt to irrigate our Mendoza desert vineyards. Las Vertientes are hand-crafted by famed Héctor and Pablo Durigutti, using 100% estate Agrelo, Mendoza fruit.

Only indigenous yeasts are used, with no fining or filtration. The winery combines a unique mix of traditional and cutting-edge winemaking.
