



Located in San Pablo, Uco Valley, at the foothill of the Andes Mountain, Tapiz's new winery in this high altitude region is dedicated exclusively to the elaboration of the Tapiz lines: Alta Collection, Selección de Barricas, Black Tears, Las Notas, Organic, Reserves and Classics.

The winery's capacity is 600.000 liters in stainless steel tanks, with 500 oak barrels - 70% French and 30% American - and equipped with a bottling line and stowage.



Home to the Tapiz Winery, this high altitude vineyard stands impressively at 1,350masl (4430ft) making it one of the highest vineyards in this region.

With 452has, the grapes from this vineyards are destined exclusively to the elaboration of the Tapiz lines.


This region - with its altitude and optimal thermal range which translates into an ideal balance of acidity and alcohol- is perfect for growing both red and white varieties.

These are wines of intense polyphenolic richness, as revealed by their marked and distinctive aromatic profile. In general they offer great aging potential and character, and a rich mouthfeel.

The white varieties stand out for their marked mineral character, while the red ones like Malbec lean towards floral aromas with deep violet hues and a solid, explosive structure.

TASTING NOTES

Red purplish color. Aromas of fresh red fruits, flowers with spicy notes. The oak aging provides vanilla and toasted almonds notes. Very rich and bulky in the mouth.

TASTING NOTES

Intense red color. Aromas of fresh red and black fruits with hints of eucalyptus.

Its oak aging contributes with notes of vanilla, coffee and chocolate. The palate is gentle, with sweet and ripe tannins.

TAPIZ ALTA COLLECTION CHARDONNAY

Single Vineyard from San Pablo Estate, Uco Valley, Mendoza.

TASTING NOTES

Bright yellow color. Aromas of citrus and orange combined with pear, honey and a slightly mineral touch. French oak adds notes of vanilla and caramel. On the palate it is persistent, with a balanced acidity and long finish.

TASTING NOTES

Intense red color. Aromas reminiscent of red fruits, blackberries, cassis and dried plums with a delicate hint of spices. Accompanied by well integrated coffee and chocolate notes. The palate is intense, with ripe and gentle tannins.



TAPIZ LAS NOTAS DE JEAN CLAUDE

Single Vineyard from San Pablo Estate, Uco Valley, Mendoza.

TASTING NOTES

This specimen expresses the maximum intensity on the nose, with finesse, elegance and harmony generated by our terroir. On the nose, notes of fresh red fruits, raspberries, cassis and truffles accompanied by delicate spicy hints. Its oak aging brings aromas of coffee and chocolate amalgamated with fruity notes typical of this varietal from San Pablo Estate. The palate is intense, with sweet and elegant tannins. A long finish, hard to forget. A wine that represents the art of precision from the vineyard to the glass.





TAPIZ BLACK TEARS

Single Vineyard from San Pablo Estate, Uco Valley, Mendoza.

TASTING NOTES

Intense purplish red color. Aromas of ripe red fruits, dried plums, figs and jams, with subtle floral and menthol hints. The oak adds notes of roasted coffee, dark chocolate and caramel. On the palate it is meaty, with sweet and ripe tannins. Presents licorice notes with a long finish. A complex and balanced specimen.
