Wapisa is the only winery that exists in this unique coastal terroir.





Located 12 miles away from the Atlantic, in an agricultural colony. On the banks of the Río Negro river, it is the only Patagonian Winery with vineyards that have a maritime influence.

The temperate climate of the area is heavily influenced by ocean winds, with high temperatures in the summer yet cool nights owing to the proximity of the sea. The region offers an exceptional balance of latitude, air humidity, rainfall, day temperatures in particular, which never go beyond 30° C (86° F), and mild temperatures at night.

Clay loam soils with very good water retention and abundant organic matter. Rocks predominate below the top one-meter layer (40 in.), which offers good drainage. Altitude: 100 masl / 328 fasl.

the estate is irrigated by means of permanently lined ditches and a drainage system that brings water harvested from the Río Negro River to more than 20,000 ha (49,500 acres).in San Javier, Viedma.





The winery's capacity is 300.000 liters in stainless steel tanks and has 150 oak barrels, 80% French and 20% American.

The combination of climate and soil conditions create almost magical grapes that are able to ripe slowly, showing good health and perfect hydration levels. As a result, we obtain edgier wines with excellent balance between acidity and alcohol content and very fresh aromas. Notes of liquorice and a hint of red fruits and not overly sweet flowers stand out. Very stylish, these are wines where verticality and delicacy prevail.

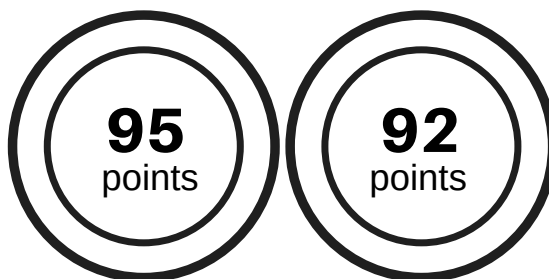
