OLD VINE ZINFANDEL 2023

VINTAGE NOTES

WINERY INFORMATION: LangeTwins is a fifth generation Lodi winery with over 5,000 acres of estate fruit. Our vineyards are certified green by Lodi Rules Sustainable Wine-growing.

LABEL NOTES: For five generations the Lange family has lived and worked our land in Lodi, California, always striving to leave the land in a better state for the next generation.

WINEMAKING: Premium Lodi vineyards harvested at 25.5 Brix. Each vineyard was fermented as an individual lot, to bring out the best in each wine. The vineyards were then combined for aging with Premium French and American oaks that were selected for their sweet toasty flavors, nuances of vanilla and warm, smokey spice. Before bottling, the wine was blended for complexity with Petite Sirah for color and dark berry flavors, Barbera for acidity and bright red fruit, Nero d'Avola for brightness. And Tannat and Teroldego for structure and concentration.

CLIMATE: Classic Mediterranean. Lodi takes advantage of the gap between the northern and southern coastal ranges surrounding the San Francisco Bay. As the day's temperature rises, cool breezes drift in from the Delta, keeping the nights cool which is ideal for the development of complexity in finished wines.

COLOR: Deep Ruby Red

TASTING NOTES: Sweet jammy fruit, dense blackberry, boysenberry and black cherry layered with sweet and smokey spice. Soft texture, full body, luscious, sweet ripe fruit flavors and finish.
