VINTAGE NOTES

WINERY INFORMATION: Tassajara Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the sustainably certified vineyards of the Scheid Family located in Monterey, CA. The name Tassajara comes from the famed Tassajara Hot Springs, where legend has it the natives would go for renewing spiritual energy. The Scheid Family uses 100% renewable energy in the form of Wind Powered Turbines.

MONTEREY AVA: The vineyards benefit from the cool climate and maritime influences from the Monterey Bay, as well as the surrounding mountains which serve to make this a unique micro-climate. Made from 100% estate grown grapes.

WINEMAKING: The grapes were harvested in the early morning hours based on ripeness, acidity, pH and seed color. In the winery, the fruit was sorted, crushed and fermented in small lots. Gentle handling and minimal intervention preserved the integrity of the variety and the character of the individual sites.

COLOR: Dark ruby red

TASTING NOTES: Bursting with aromas of blackberry, elderberry and plum. Accented by hints of vanilla and cedar. It is medium bodied with nicely structured tannins and flavors of bright black fruit with a lingering sweet oak finish.
